

Question and Answers during Team Leaders' Meeting on Aug. 12, 2022

1. If there are three teams in a Group, how will the advanced teams be decided? (China Team Leader)

Ans. See “How to determine the teams that advance to the final rounds?”

2. Due to the inconsistent answers from the FAQs concerning the lagori stacking, we would like to reconfirm, according to the latest FAQ released on 11th August, it is true that we are allowed to stack the lagori outside the lagori base then pile multiple lagori discs in the same time?

Ans. Yes.

It is allowed to stack the Lagori discs outside of the Lagori base then pile multiple Lagori discs at the same time.

FAQ5 1.20.16 and FAQ3 1.20-4 are incorrect as the rule was changed for the online contest.

3. Considering the network latency during the overseas online meeting, will the timing of the game be based on the referee's timer or will the recorded streaming be reviewed and the judged according to the real game time?

Ans. Referee's time in India will be considered final.

4. Is it mandatory to use the Wasan Balls, or are we allowed to use our respective balls as long as they follow the specifications written in the rules? In consideration of the one Wasan Ball we received from our national committee has a diameter of 155 mm whereas the rules state it has to be 140mm with a 5% tolerance.

Ans. Use sizes for the pressure of 6 PSI (gauge), about 0.48 Bar (gauge). Inform the sizes to the contest committee in advance (by Aug. 18, 2022) for approval.

5. Which team will advance in the following scenario (Chun Wa YIP)

Game 1

Team 1 – 45 marks 15s piling

Team 2 – 55 marks 25s piling

Game 2

Team 1 – 45 marks 16s piling

Team 2 – 55 marks 26s piling

Game 3

Team 1 – 45 marks 17s piling

Team 2 – 55 marks 27s piling

Ans. Team 1 of Game 1 wins.

6. (a) Is there a margin of error for the ball speed?
(b) Can the platform of the head ball be hollowed out?
(c) Is there are three teams in a group, how will THE advanced teams be decided.
(China Team Leader)

Ans. (a) Yes.

The speed of the ball ejected by both R1 and R2 must be within 30 km / h. Use a speed gun during the robot check to make sure the ball's ejection speed is within 30 kilometers. If you throw the ball 5 times and the speed is $30 \pm 3 \text{ km / h}$ 4 times, you will pass the robot check. [* Measure with a speed gun (Bushnell Speed Star V) 1 m away from the robot in the direction of ball ejection].



(b) Yes, they are hollow.

- 1st Round
- 1-1 Team A break the Lagori and scores 25 points
1-2 Team B shot down 4 BOHH in 20 seconds.
1-3 Team A piled up 3 Lagori in 20 seconds and scores 30 points.
- 2nd Round
- 2-1 Team B break the Lagori and scores 25 points
2-2 Team A shot down 4 BOHH in 43 seconds.
2-3 Team B piled up 3 Lagori in 12 seconds, then 43 seconds elapsed without piling up.

Ans. Team B wins.

8. May I Know if the 4 poles that hold the balls can be placed on the stage during the lagori shooting? Or it is needed to be removed until the shooting balls round. (Chandra Yi)

Ans. All 4 poles will be fixed and remain there throughout the game.

9. When restarting, should our R2 go back to the starting zone? (China Team_Leader)

Ans. Yes. R2 goes back to starting zone

10. (a) How do we determine the advancing team of the preliminary round if the total scores are a tie?

Ans. See “How to determine the teams that advance to the final rounds?”

(b) The Wasan balls stated in the rule book is larger than 147mm (140mm +5%) with 6 PSI?
Can we use it? If yes, do we need to tell you in advance? If no, what can do now?

15. Let us consider that in a certain group, all the teams could score BOHH within a few seconds because of them none of them will be able to score 75 points. Ans. Yes. As per “How to determine the teams that advance to the final rounds?” those teams win and advances to the next round.

Question: If the Lagori goes outside the Lagori area, can we use it.

Ans. No.

1.17 of Online Game Rules says “The Lagori disc which has gone out of the Lagori Area including its space above, even partially, cannot be used again.” Also, 1.19 of Online Game Rules says “However, if there is a Lagori disc which has gone out of the Lagori Area and cannot be used, you can continue piling up the Lagori except for that disc.”
